



PREPARING TO HIT THE ROAD AGAIN

As states and provinces reopen, it's important to take precautions to keep yourself and those around you safe.

Conduct road-ready check

If you haven't driven your vehicle for some time, make sure it's road-ready by checking tire pressure, fluid levels and registration expiration dates.

Plan ahead

Carry enough water and snacks inside your vehicle for the day to limit the need to stop at convenience stores or restaurants. Plan extra time for your trip as there may be increased amounts of traffic as more people return to the roadway.

Call first

Repair shops, upfit facilities and dealerships may see some aftereffects including longer than normal wait or lead times for their regular activities. Call the provider to understand their visitation protocols and to schedule an appointment.

Take fueling precautions

If possible, pay at the pump. Consider sanitizing surfaces before and disinfecting hands after use. Or wear gloves to minimize potential exposure.
