State	Status	Standard Cycle Time	Estimated Extended Cycle Time
CA	Extended Processing	30-90 business days	Title corrections can take up to 180 business days to complete.
CO	Extended Processing	10-15 business days	Processing time is 6 to 8 weeks. Denver counties are processing transactions from Nov. 4th. DC	Extended Processing	26-30 business days	Processing time is 8 to 10 weeks.
DE	Extended Processing	10-25 business days	Processing time is 8 to 10 weeks. The county is processing work dated 10/19.
IL	Extended Processing DMV Closures due to limited staffing	5-15 business days	Wheels has inventory for renewals, new plates and state transfers (passenger & B class) in-house. For all other work types requests are sent to the DMV for processing. January 3-17 IL DMV offices will be closed. MN	Sticker Shortage	26-30 business days	Impacting renewals and cab cards. MN DMV is working with law enforcement to extend January renewals through Feb 10th. MO	Staffing Shortages	36-60 business days	Plates (initial title and registration, state transfers, ownership transfers) and renewals delayed in Jefferson County. The county is processing work from 10/15 due to staffing shortages.
MS	Extended Processing	61-75 business days	Title processing is taking up to 120 days to complete
MT	Extended Processing	10-25 business days	New plates and state transfers delayed due to aluminum shortage. Expected to catch up by 12/31/21 https://apnews.com/article/business-montana-1d65c48e19f115e9bad4f6e3228cbf5a
