

Title & Registration Alert - Motor Vehicle Facility Delays

The below information is current through June 1, 2022

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, select DMVs/MOTs continue to have extended processing times. Wheels continues to work to leverage online capabilities and expedite processing of registrations where possible. More information is available online at our [COVID Resource Center](#).

State	Status	Standard Cycle Time	Estimated Extended Cycle Time
CO	Extended Processing	10-15 business days	<p>Processing time is 6 to 8 weeks. Denver counties are processing transactions from April 18th.</p> <p>Temp tags are good for 60 days. DE	Extended Processing (New plates/state transfers)	10-25 business days	<p>There is a statewide delay at the DE DMV. To have a temp tag issued, drivers need to have a VIN inspection completed and sent to Wheels. Impacted Wheels drivers were contacted proactively between 3/24-3/31. If a Power of Attorney or lease agreement is needed, drivers can contact Wheels to provide. A 2nd temp tag is available if needed and follows the same process as the 1st. Wheels did a 2nd outreach campaign to DE drivers in mid-May.</p> <p>Drivers can use the following link to complete the verbal permit form required:</p> <p>https://dmv.de.gov/forms/index.shtml</p> <p>The state has 4,411 pending new plates to issue. Various offices are working on submissions from between 2/25-3/24.</p>
FL	Extended Processing	11-15 business days	<p>June renewals may be delayed. Wheels Donlen has been made aware of system issues that are delaying renewal processing. All registrations are expected to be completed by the expiration date of 6/30/22.</p>
HI	Extended Processing	16-25 business days	<p>HI experiencing delays due to system integration and staff training. The DMV integration project will combine the Drivers Licensing and Motor Vehicle Registration divisions into one full-service DMV.</p> <p>Safety inspections will continue to be honored if they are still valid on the date they are received at the DMV.</p> <p>https://spectrumlocalnews.com/hi/hawaii/community/2022/04/04/kauai-dmv-to-close-at-3-p-m--daily-every-other-week</p>
UT	Sticker Supply	26-35 business days	<p>The Utah DMV had notified the public of a shortage of sticker supply in April 2022. As of May 1, the state expects the supply issue to be resolved, and business will return to normal. Any missing stickers can be replaced for a \$5.00 fee.</p> <p>Units that expired between 2/28/22-4/30/22 are potentially impacted. Wheels Donlen is working with the state and vendors to obtain duplicates for all vehicles that did not receive a sticker.
